



Housewares Dos and Don'ts

The following is a brief guideline of the dos and don'ts when consigning houseware items. We reserve the right to turn away items that we do not feel fit the criteria to sell.

Please remember:

- We accept a variety of housewares! Picture frames, wall art, pots/pans, place settings, platters and plates, small kitchen appliances, utensils, pet items, home décor, holiday décor, nursery décor, children's decorative pillows, collegiate items, and so much more!
- Large wall art is limited to 3 per consignor.
- Items must be in very good condition. Please clean your items.
- Kitchen items must have all pieces and be in working order.
- No appliances over 3 years old.
- No curtains or curtain rods.
- No bedding of any kind (not including baby blankets).
- No fabric.
- No bed pillows. Gently used nursery pillows or décor pillows are okay.
- No used candles. If a candle has a burnt wick, it will be thrown away!
- No knives. Do NOT bring these.
- Items must be rust-free.
- No home repair items.
- No video tapes (NO VHS).
- Copiers, printers, computers, TVs have to be less than 3 years old.
- No individual lamp shades.
- No souvenir/plastic cups or single coffee mugs. Sets are okay.
- No USED bath and beauty items. This includes combs, hair curlers, makeup, lotions, etc. **WE WILL ONLY ACCEPT ITEMS NEW IN UNOPENED PACKAGING.**
- Furniture must be clean and free of smoke and pet hair.
- Furniture must be in good condition. Everyone loves a fixer upper, but please do not bring in anything broken, containing water damage, or with deep scratches.
- All housewares must be seasonally appropriate.
- No more of 3 of the same exact item.
