

Children's Dos and Don'ts

The following is a brief guideline of the dos and don'ts when consigning children's items. We reserve the right to turn away items that we do not feel fit the criteria to sell.

CLOTHING:

- All clothing items must be in good condition. Do not bring items with stains, holes, missing buttons/zippers.
 - DISCLAIMER: our store lights really show staining. Please do not take offense if we see yellowing and give it back to you. If you are questioning any stains being present, take your items outside in the sunlight to assess.
- Clothing must be seasonally appropriate.
- Price your items to sell. We know items can bring up sentimental feelings, but people are not going to pay top dollar for an item your baby first walked in just because it's special to you. {Sorry!} Limit 15 shoes per consignor. Shoes must be in very good shape!
- No more than 4 of the same items.
- No 3 letter monograms. Monogrammed names are okay.
- Limit 10 onsies and 10 sleepers (per gender) per consignor.
 - TIP: one hanger counts as one sleeper! Put 2-3 sleepers on one hanger and sell as a bundle. They sell better that way!
- Package baby bows, socks, mittens, and bibs in ziplock bags.
- Bottles and feeding items need to be in excellent condition.
- Used underwear will not be accepted. Only NEW IN PACKAGE.

EQUIMENT AND ACCESSORIES:

- No crib mattresses, children's bedding, or curtains will be accepted.
- No potties or diaper pails UNLESS NEW IN BOX.
- Highchairs, walkers, bumbos, playmats, bathtubs, bouncers, etc. must be clean! We will turn away yucky items with dried up food/milk.

TOYS

- All toys must have ALL pieces. If it's missing pieces, leave it at home!
- Toys must have working batteries and/or chargers.
- No naked dolls or barbies.
- If you use ziplock bags for toys, seal with tape as well!

Remember, we accept sporting goods, DVDs, gaming systems and games, dancewear, and toddler furniture too!
